

**Subject:** Minutes Of September 11, 2008 Traffic Board Meeting

The September 2008 meeting of the City Traffic Board was called to order at 2:00PM at the Main Conference of Stockbridge Facility. Meeting attendance was recorded on the sign-in-sheet.

## **Florence Street Petition for Speed Bumps**

Traffic Engineer presented the results of the second traffic study conducted on Florence Street from August 19 to 21, 2008. At the request of Ms. Jordan-Woods this study was conducted in front of the entrance to the Northside Children's Water Playground. The first traffic study was conducted in June of 2008 and the results were presented in the August meeting of the City Traffic Board. Purpose of both the traffic studies was to determine the need for speed bumps on Florence Street. Traffic Engineer reported that the results of the second traffic study are similar to that of the first traffic study except that the second traffic study recorded 20.73% fewer vehicles on Florence Street than the first study.

Traffic Board concluded that Florence Street does not meet the warrants for speed bumps, and therefore rejected the petition for speed bumps on Florence Street, and directed Traffic Engineer to place "play ground" signs on Florence Street as agreed upon in the August meeting of the Traffic Board.
