- ❖ The minutes of the February meeting accepted as presented.
- ❖ Election of Office
- ❖ Jim Roschek presented the Business Manager's Report.
  - Total revenue through February is \$13,053
  - Course Maintenance is \$17,777
  - \$25,000 was paid to the City for 2005
  - The checkbook balance is \$57,894
  - A change in clientele is being observed at the courses
  - A rate comparison with respect to other local courses was presented
  - A copy of an article in the Ann Arbor News was shared. It stated that the city's golf courses were struggling to get out of the financial rough.
- ❖ Jim Roschek presented the Greens Committee Report.
  - Debris is being cleared from the greens
  - Two trees were lost behind #10 green
  - 100, 150 and 200 yard markers are out
  - An article with respect to early play and the effect on course condition was shared
  - Milham and Eastern Hills are open for play
- ❖ Jim Roschek presented the Director of Golf report
  - A copy of the Spring 2006 Newsletter was shared
  - Milham Park will be rated this year, Eastern Hills is on hold
  - A letter of from Gary Hamminga was shared. He was critical of course conditions, the City Commission and the 15% price differential
