

"Reverse Deal" Drugs

512.1 PURPOSE

To define the procedures to control drugs held for the purpose of "Reverse Deals."

512.2 PROCEDURE

- (a) KVET will no longer keep any type of narcotics at the KVET office without prior approval of the C.O.P.S. Divisional Commander.
- (b) "Reverse Deal" drugs will now be picked up at the KDPS Lab after being tested and shall be returned to the Evidence Room directly after the reversal.
- (c) The only exception to drugs being kept at the KVET office is marijuana that needs to dry out. Such marijuana will be stored in the fenced Bulk Evidence Storage area, with a padlock securing the marijuana, for no longer than two weeks. If a suspect exists in the incident, the evidence will be packaged and submitted to the Evidence Room. If there is no suspect, the marijuana may be destroyed at KVET, with the permission of KVET's Prosecuting Attorney and the Divisional Commander.
