The meeting was called to order at 12:00 p.m. Meeting minutes from June 20th, 2024, were motioned by Kevin to approve and seconded by John B. Vote was unanimous.

**1. Director of Golf Report:**

- Dean submitted written report.
- Revenue through June continues to be strong. Core revenue is up \$110,000 vs. 2023 with overall revenue up \$143,000. Expenses are reasonably in line.
- Milham has recovered well from the storm damage. There is still a good amount to clean up, but it is mostly out of play. A big thank you to the City for helping in the process. I am expecting to receive an insurance settlement of \$41,501.28 which includes \$10,000 for tree cleanup, \$10,000 for fence damage, \$2,895.47 for irrigation repair, and \$18,606.81 in business income loss. I paid \$12,000 to 4 Seasons Tree for cleanup, and \$2,895.47 for irrigation repair, but I have not spent anything on fence repair yet. The estimated quote to repair all fence damage was over \$35,000. For business income, Milham was closed for 6 days, and received 3 days of reimbursement. Ron estimates over 700 hours were spent on cleanup the first week

along with 60 hours of irrigation repair. Tree Fellers had 8 guys on site for 7 days at a cost of \$84,000.

- Milham irrigation upgrade was put on hold after the storm damage but is expected to resume soon. 6 holes are completed.
- Drive Chip and Putt was held at Milham on July 8 with 64 participants. 16 participants advanced to the sub-regional at Boulder Creek on 8/17.
- State Representative Julie Rogers is expected to present a proclamation for the 100-year anniversary of the KMGGA at 8:15 am during the Red Arrow Benefit.
