PURPOSE:

To establish procedures and conditions for the placement of special, commemorative signs.

SCOPE:

The policy applies to all requests to the City for the placement of commemorative signs within the City of Kalamazoo.

POLICY:

DEFINITION – As used in the policy, a supplemental information sign shall be a sign placed under a City Limit sign indicating special high school, college or university achievements, or city special designations such as tree city, city management approved slogan, etc.

GENERAL CONDITIONS – Supplemental information signs shall only be located immediately below a city limit sign on the same sign support structure. The maximum number of supplemental information signs allowed at each location is one (1). The supplemental information sign shall be of the same size as the city limit sign (generally 48" x 30") it is placed under.

An application form must be filled out with all necessary information before request can be considered.
