- ** -The hourly cost of **Item 1** includes labor to collect, bag, and remove debris from the site.
- The cost for **Item 2** includes only the cost to collect and transport tires from the site to 1415 Harrison, Kalamazoo MI.
- Item 3** includes only the cost to collect and transport biohazardous materials to the Household Hazardous Waste Center at 1301 Lamont, Kalamazoo MI.
- The cubic yard cost of **Item 4** includes only the cost for Contractor to self-haul trash from sites containing less than 20 yards of total trash. For this pay item, Contractor should indicate total costs per yard including all labor, materials, fuel, equipment, overhead and disposal fees including transfer station fees. The City will not provide a container or packer truck in these instances. Contractor will perform this hauling in 10-yard, or less, increments.
- All sharps will be collected in five-gallon buckets and delivered to Hospital Network Ventures, 6212 American Avenue, Portage, MI 49002.
- Costs for disposal of material, hazardous waste and tire recycling will be paid by the City.**
- **The hourly cost of Item 5 includes all labor, fuel, and all other costs associated with the operation of the heavy equipment. For the purposes of this contract, heavy equipment will mean wheeled or**

tracked construction or maintenance equipment, such as skid steer loaders, bulldozers, graders, backhoes, front-end loaders, dashers and heavy maintenance trucks.
