The purpose of this addendum is to clarify and/or modify the Drawings and/or Specifications for this project. All work affected is subject to all applicable terms and conditions of the Bidding and Contract Documents.

1. **REVISED**: Section II – Bid and Award - Changes in **RED** - Page 2 Only

CLARIFICATIONS:

- 1. Add one treated 2x4 plate and one standard wood plate under the trusses. The plates shall be located under the trusses at each vertical leg of the structural tees and around the perimeter of the roof. Provide hurricane clips between truss and plates and fasten the plates to the deck.
- 2. Roof loading is 30 PSI ground snow load

23.1 flat roof

- 3. The steel roof shall be a 24 ga. double lock standing seam roof with 1 1/2" seams at 16" O.C.
- 4. The standing seam roof warranty requirements are in the specifications.
- 5. Provide cement board trim for the cement board siding.
- 6. Provide an alternate price for metal siding in lieu of the cement board siding. The metal siding shall be prefinished, 24 ga, with concealed fasteners, provide all standard corner and base trim, etc. to provide a complete installation. The siding shall have a 20-year prorated finish warranty. Manufacturers approved for the standing seam metal roof are approved for the metal siding. Contractor shall provide shop drawings including siding profiles color and warranty information for the owner's selection during the submittal process after being awarded the project.
- 7. The metal roof warranty requirements are listed in the specifications.
- 8. Standing Seam Metal Roof- DMI Double Lock DL15 is an accepted alternate roof to the standing seam roof specified in the project manual. The DMI Roof panel must meet the standing seam specification requirements listed in the project manual.
- 9. Provide two porcelain keyless socket lights with 100-watt LED light bulbs and one light switch/motion detector switch.
- 10. The City will address the removal and reinstallation of the antenna. The Contractor shall coordinate removal of the antenna with the City and inform the City of when it must be removed with adequate time for the City to address removal.
- 11. Site restoration is the responsibility of the Contractor.
- 12. The existing precast twin tee roof structure was originally designed to carry:

Live load 80 PSF

Superimposed dead load 30 PSF

Superimposed earth load 180 PSF.

13. Final contractor questions regarding bidding shall change from May 19, 2022, to May 16, 2022 to allow for preparation of an addendum and time for the Contractors to address the addendum in their bid.

Present Overall Project Scope of Work

Project Description: The project consists of removing the earthen cover, constructing framing, and installing a standing seam metal roof. The work includes:

- 1. Civil/Site Work
 - a. Provide Traffic control as needed to remove/excavate the existing earthen roof
 - b. Obtain Right of Way Permit from City
 - c. Remove earthen roof
 - d. Grade site
 - e. Provide restoration of areas disturbed
- 2. Architectural Work including:
 - a. Seal existing concrete structure with liquid applied roof membrane
 - b. Construct framing
 - c. Place standing seam metal roof.
- 3. Administration work
 - a. Project Close out paperwork
 - b. Testing and balancing
 - c. Provide warranties

PRE-BID MEETING MINUTES

- Will Clarify in Addendum 1 Provide warranties as noted in technical specifications.
- The water station is to be kept operational during construction. Disruptions should be kept to a minimum to account for water supply functions.

Site Requirements

- Hours: Construction on site shall be limited to 7am to 5pm unless coordinated with the City.
- Discuss Parameters for Normal contractor operations:
 - Parking Locations, Material Deliveries and Construction Trailer. Space in the lower level will be set aside for the Contractor's use.
 - Gate Key will be issued to Contractor
 - Storage Areas: Shall be located in areas designated by the City.
- Security: Building must be kept secure during construction and all required egress paths must be maintained.
- Contractor Decorum and Conduct: See City Requirements: Shirts required, no profanity, tobacco, or lewd behavior.
- Temporary Contractor Use of Utilities and Facilities:
 - Notify the owner not less than two days in advance of proposed utility interruptions and obtain owners written permission before proceeding.
 - Water/Electric: coordinate with Owner as needed.
 - Restrooms: Temporary Porta John can be placed.

A project walk through will be was performed.

- 1. City will remove and replace the communications antenna as needed.
- 2. See alternative bid items in Addendum No.1.
