		<div>• For network drops, we use Panduit Mini-Com at Crosstown. At the ends of the network runs--for each triplex receptacle--you'll need one Panduit CFP SL4WHY faceplate. You'll also need three Cat6 modules (Panduit CJ688TGBU) and one blank (Panduit CMBWH-X).</div> <div>• At the patch panel/network room side of the runs, you'll simply need the appropriate number of Cat6 Modules (Panduit CJ688TGBU), so 3 for a triplex network receptacle. This assumes we'll reuse available space in the existing patch panels.</div> <div>• For single receptacles, I'd prefer the Panduit CFP SL2IWY faceplate with one Panduit CFP SL2IWY blank each (and of course the Panduit CJ688TGBU module jack). This will provide us a little expansion space if needed at any of those locations.</div>
