BOIL WATER ADVISORY Water Main Break Repair Piccadilly Road, City of Kalamazoo

January 23th, 2019, Kalamazoo MI – The City of Kalamazoo is in the process of repairing a water main break on Piccadilly Road that resulted in a temporary loss of pressure. Consequently, a precautionary boil water advisory is being issued in cooperation with the Kalamazoo County Health and Community Services Department for all water intended for drinking or ingestion or any consumptive uses within the affected area (see attached figure), including:

Piccadilly Road – From West Main Street (southern boundary) to Sunnydale Avenue (northern boundary), both sides of the street. Includes the northwest corner of Piccadilly Road and Sunnydale Avenue.

Sunnydale Avenue – From Piccadilly Road (eastern boundary) to Darby Lane (western boundary), both sides of the street. Does NOT include the northwest corner of Sunnydale Avenue and Darby Lane.

Darby Lane – From Sunnydale Avenue (northern boundary) south to dead end of Darby Lane (southern boundary), both sides of the street.

West Main Street – All of businesses in Westwood Plaza. Excludes 4516, 4630, 4634, 4644, and 4646 West Main Street. Includes the northeast corner of West Main Street and Piccadilly Road

This advisory is precautionary only; there have not been any confirmed tests showing bacteria present in the water main at the location of the infrastructure repair. Initial sampling results will be available within 24 hours of its collection and the final set within 48 hours. It is expected that the advisory will be lifted within 72 hours (January 26).

Municipal water customers in the affected area may use bottled water for consumptive purposes or boil their tap water for 2 minutes prior to use for drinking or other ingestion. No special precautionary measures are necessary for water used for personal hygiene.
