LIFTING OF THE PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER ADVISORY Water Main Break Repair Nichols Road, Kalamazoo Township

March 14, 2019, Kalamazoo, MI – As of Thursday, March 14, 2019, at 9:30 a.m., the precautionary boil water advisory issued March 11, 2019 has been lifted by the City of Kalamazoo, in cooperation with the Kalamazoo County Health and Community Services Department. Citizens in the affected area can now use City water for consumption as well as all other purposes. Bacteriological sampling within the affected area verified that the water is safe to drink. The affected area is as follows:

Nichols Road – From Iroquois Trail (northern boundary) to Haskell Street (southern boundary), both sides of the street. Does not include the southwest corner of Nichols Road and Iroquois Trail.

Huron Avenue – Mohawk Street (western boundary) to Nichols Road (eastern boundary), both sides of the street.

Marlane Avenue – Mohawk Street (western boundary) to Nichols Road (eastern boundary), both sides of the street.

Mohawk Street – only the southeast corner of Mohawk Street and Marlane Avenue.
