## **LIFTING OF THE PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER ADVISORY Water Infrastructure Repair Egleston Avenue, City of Kalamazoo**

March 3, 2019, Kalamazoo, MI – As of Sunday, March 3, 2019, at 2:30 p.m., the precautionary boil water advisory issued February 28, 2019 has been lifted by the City of Kalamazoo, in cooperation with the Kalamazoo County Health and Community Services Department. Citizens in the affected area can now use City water for consumption as well as all other purposes. Bacteriological sampling within the affected area verified that the water is safe to drink. The affected area is as follows:

**East Stockbridge Avenue** – Includes the following corners: the southwest and southeast corners of East Stockbridge Avenue and Reed Court and the southeast corner of East Stockbridge Avenue and Bank Street

**Egleston Ave (Section 1)** – From Bank Street (eastern boundary) west to dead end of Egleston Avenue (western boundary), both sides of the street.

**Egleston Ave (Section 2)** – From Fair Street (eastern boundary) to Bank Street (western boundary), north side of the street.

**Reed Court** – From East Stockbridge Avenue (northern boundary) to Egleston Avenue (southern boundary), both sides of the street.

**Bank Street** – From East Stockbridge Avenue (northern boundary) to Egleston Avenue (southern boundary), both sides of the street. Includes the southwest corner of Bank Street and Egleston Avenue.
